



9 Things To Know About International Car Shipping

1) How is my car shipped overseas?

Your car can be shipped overseas in a container, or your car can be rolled on and off of the ship ("roll on roll off" or RO/RO transport). We'll present you with all of your options so that you can make the best decision based on your specific needs and budget.

2) What is the cheapest way to ship my car abroad?

Container shipping is more expensive than RO/RO transport.

3) Will I have to go through customs when I ship my car abroad?

4) Do I have to pay import duties when I ship my vehicle overseas?

Import duties vary depending upon final destination. Cargo Experts will provide you with all the import-related information that you need to ship your vehicle overseas.

5) Should I get insurance for my car when I ship it abroad?

Yes, we recommend insurance coverage for all your overseas shipping. We offer insurance policies to cover the value of your vehicle in the rare event that something happens during transport.

6) What paperwork do I need in order to ship my car abroad?

You should have a copy of your original car title, and if applicable, a letter from the lien holder. Sometimes a bill of sale is also needed. We'll guide you through the process and make sure you have all of the necessary paperwork.

7) How much fuel should be in my car when I ship it abroad?

It's advisable that you leave no more than a quarter of a tank of gas in your car.

8) What additional preparation is advisable before I ship my car overseas?

Prior to international shipping, we recommend that you

- Wash and clean your car inside and out.
- Take off removable luggage, bike, and/or ski racks.
- Lower your antenna.
- Turn off and deactivate your car alarm.

9) Is there a limit to the number of vehicles that I can ship overseas?
